- . swimming gear, towel, water.

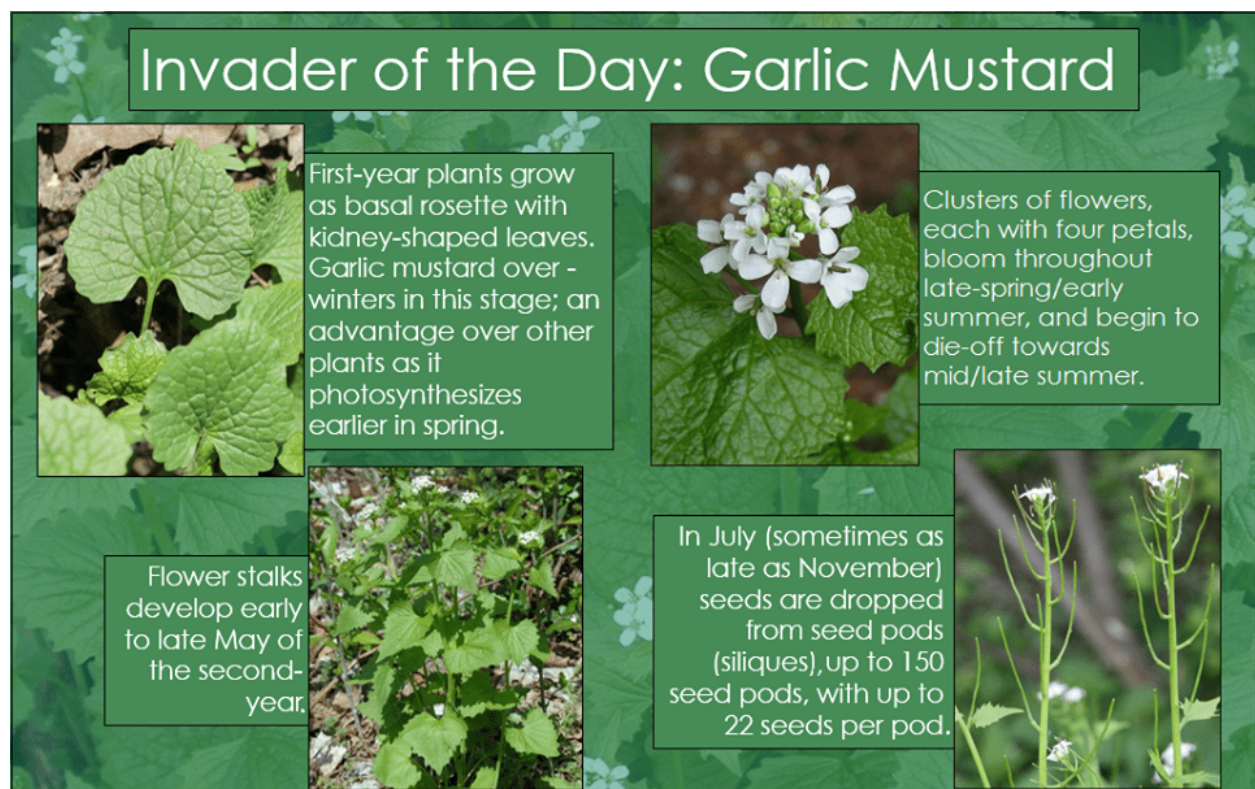
We meet at Regatta Road and the Martin Goodman Trail.
